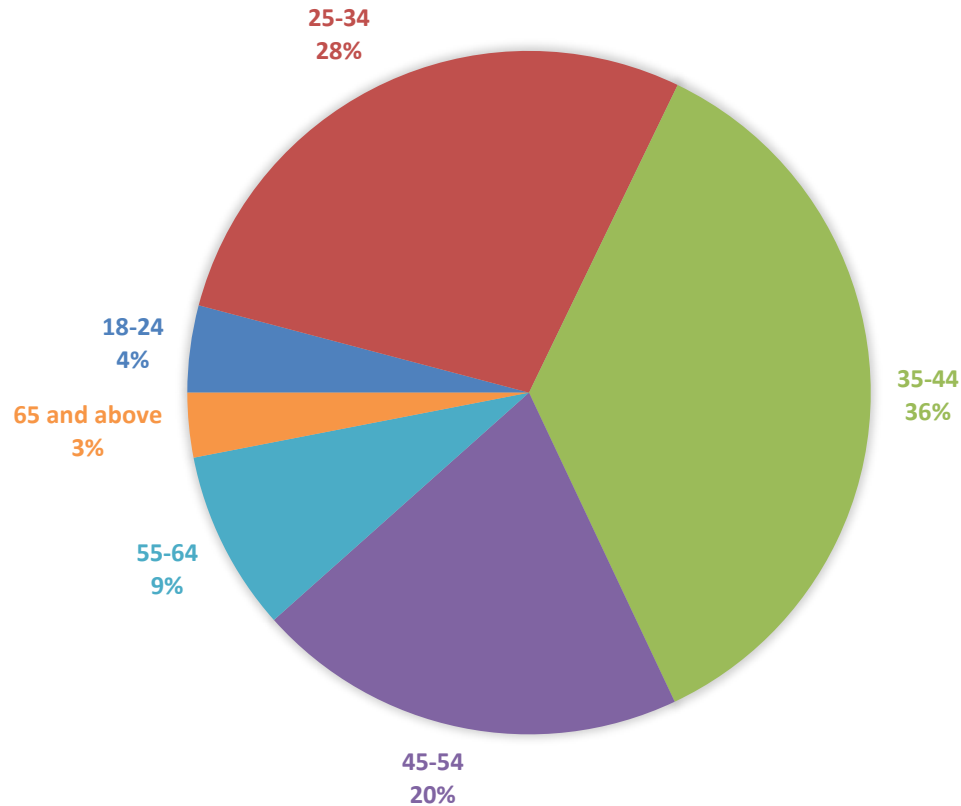

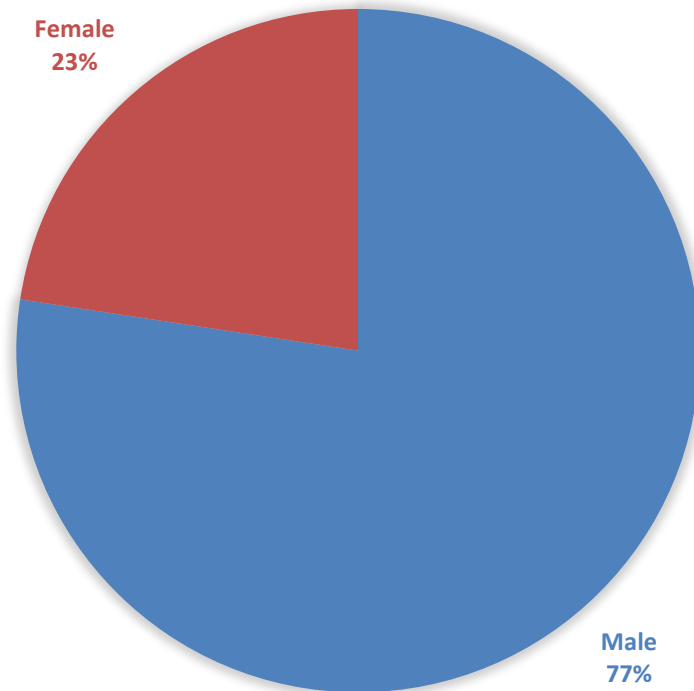

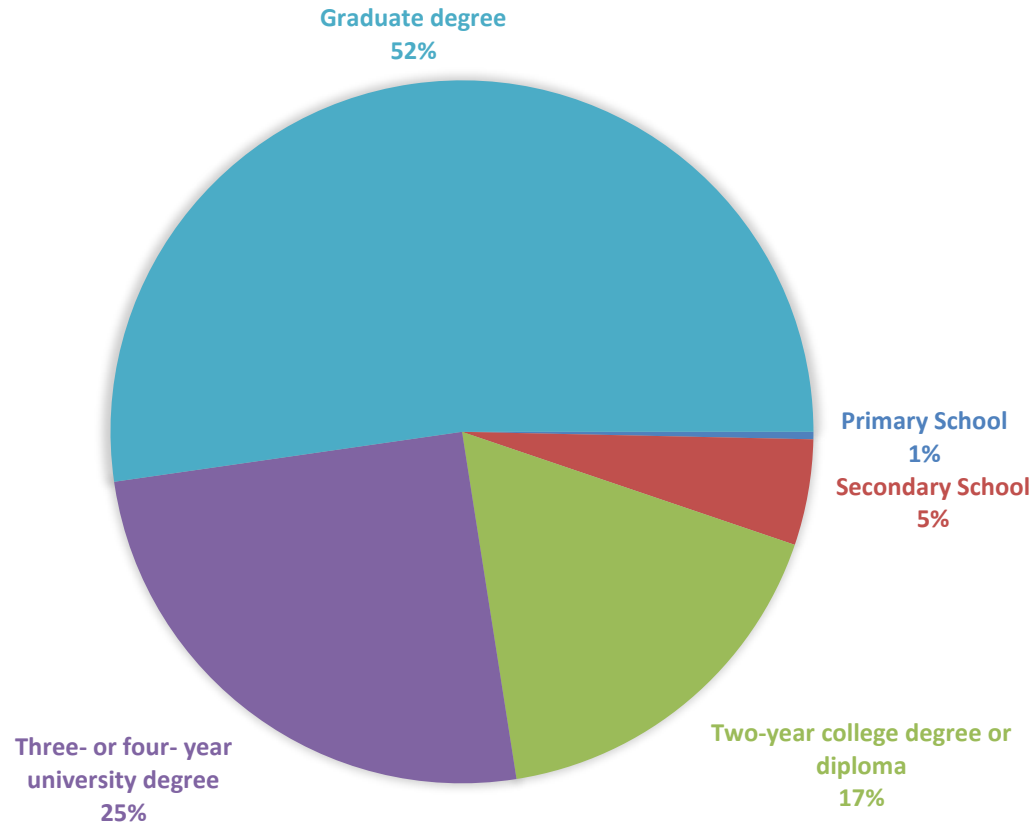
Age of survey respondents



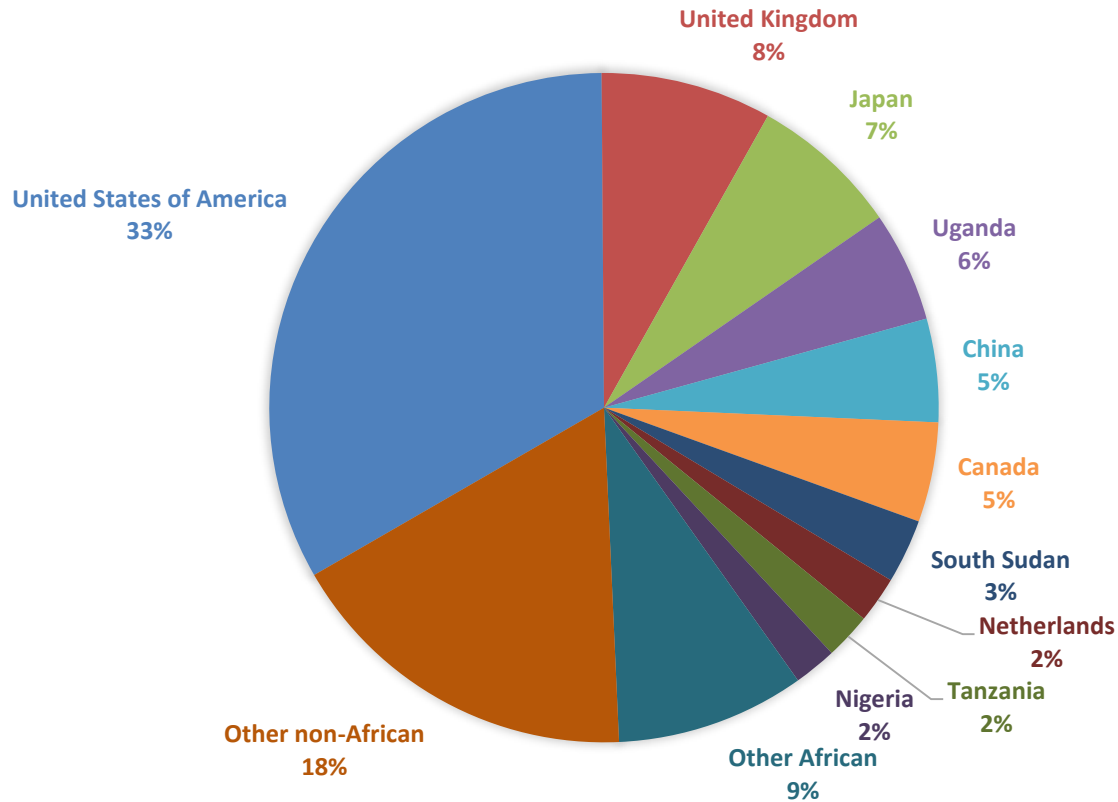
Gender of survey respondents



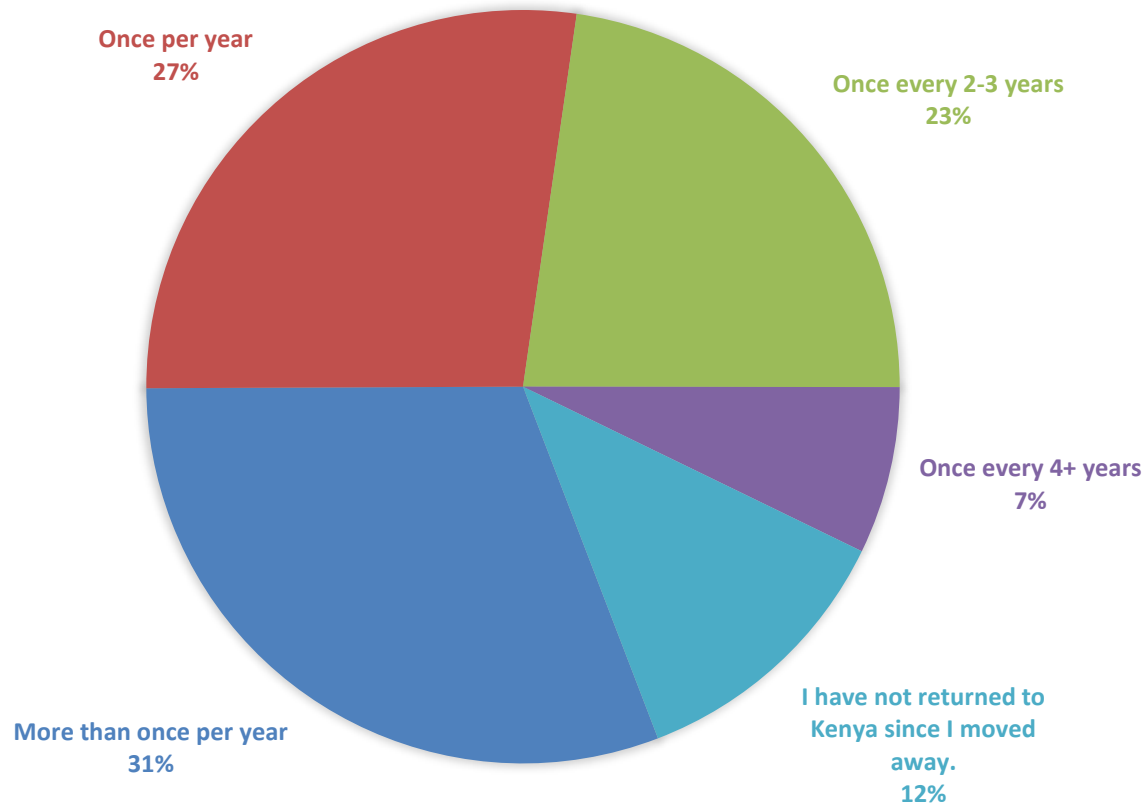
Education level



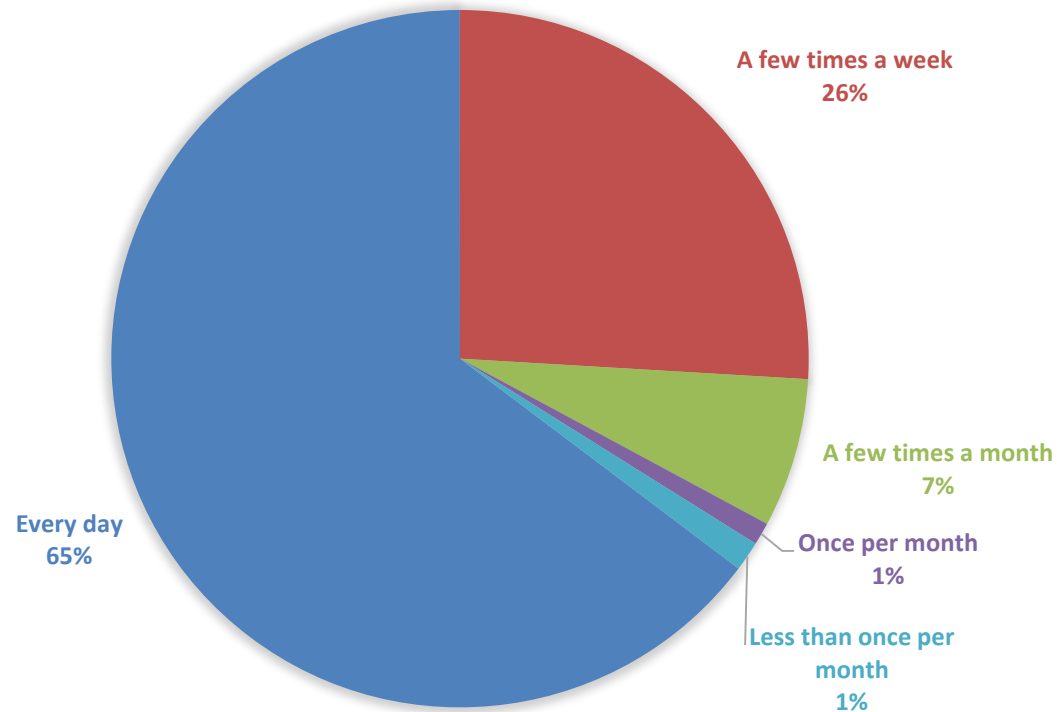
Country of residence



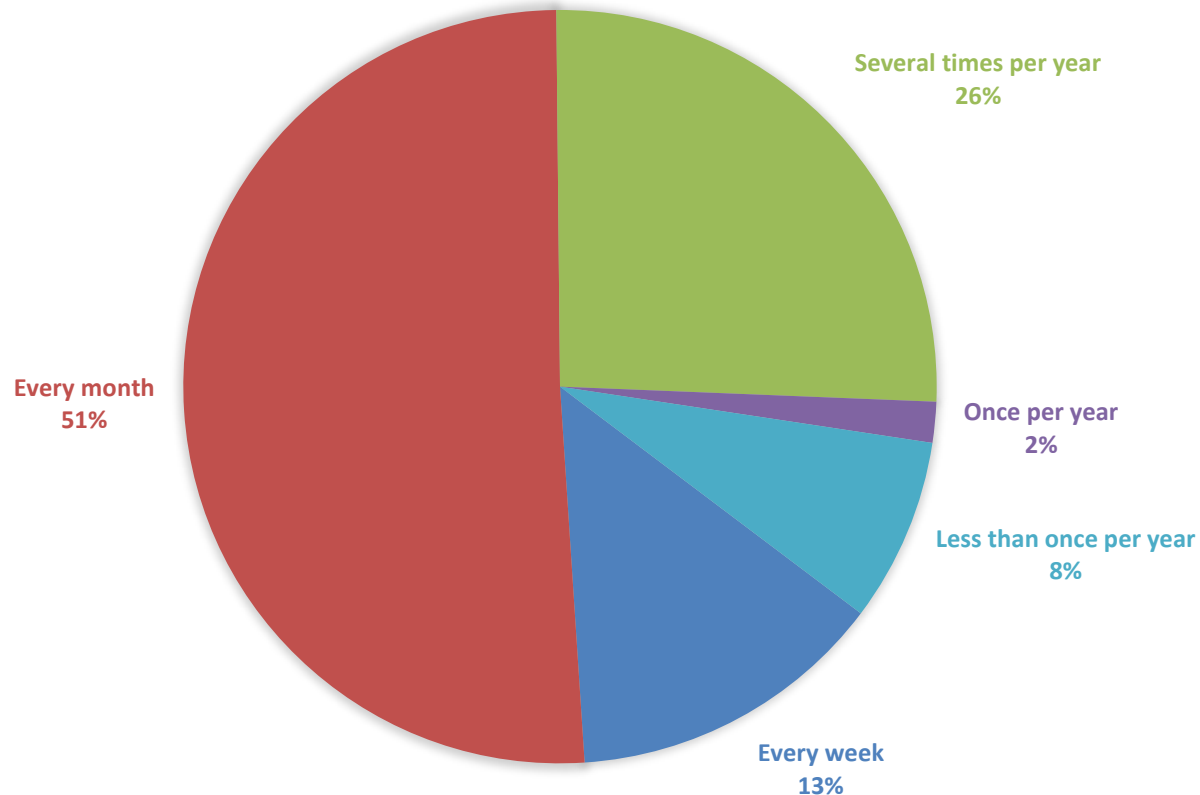
How often do you return to Kenya?



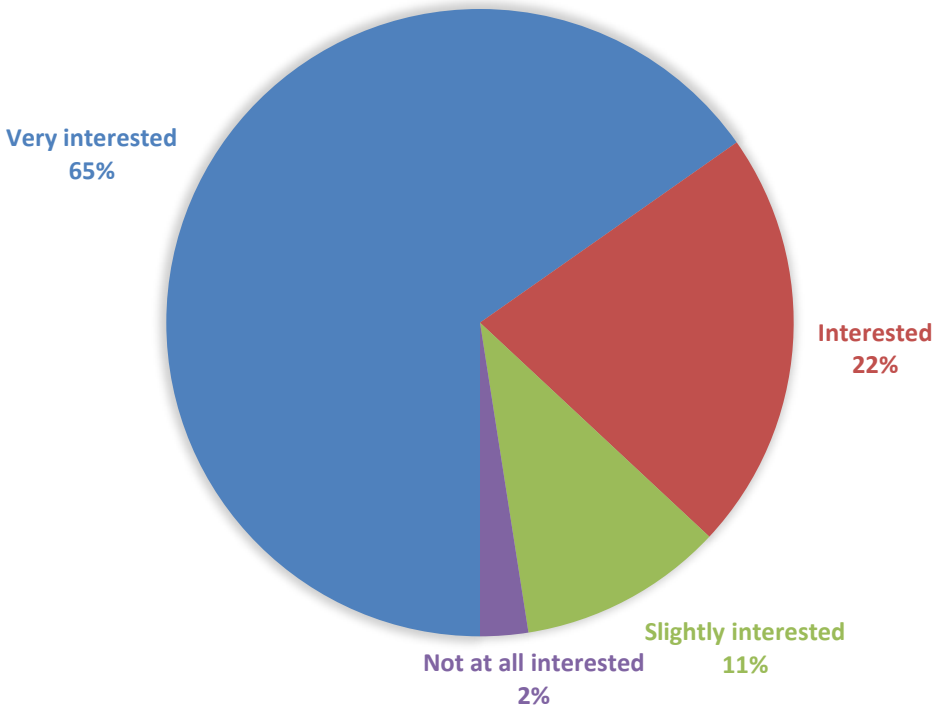
How often do you communicate with people in Kenya?



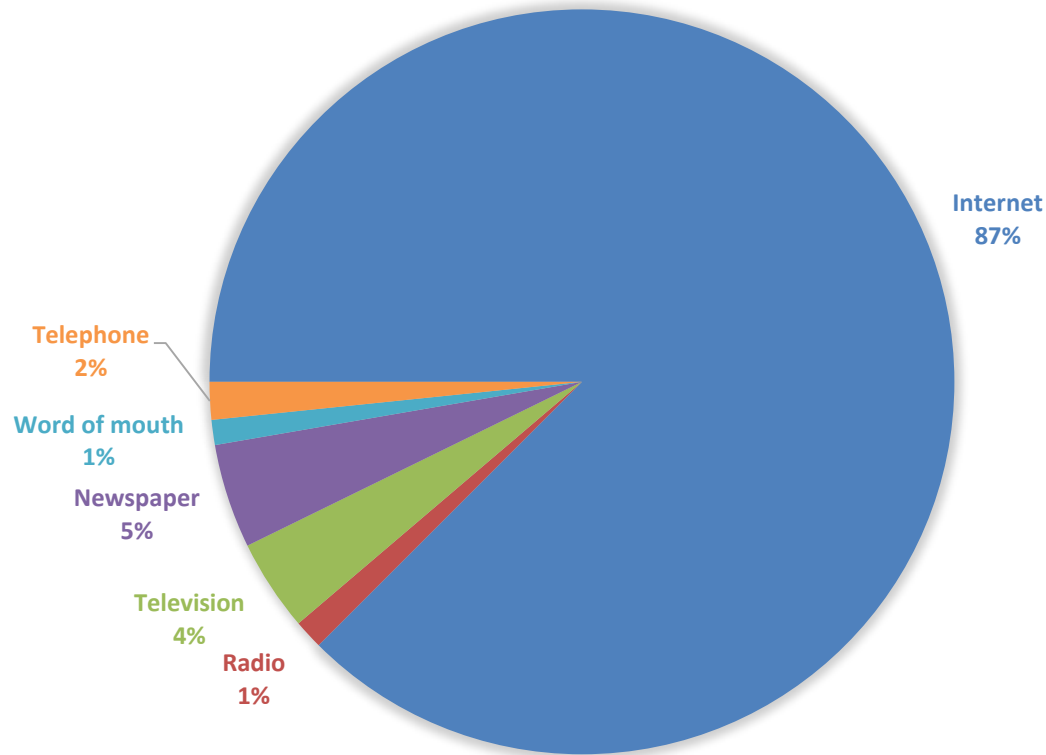
How often do you send money to people in Kenya?



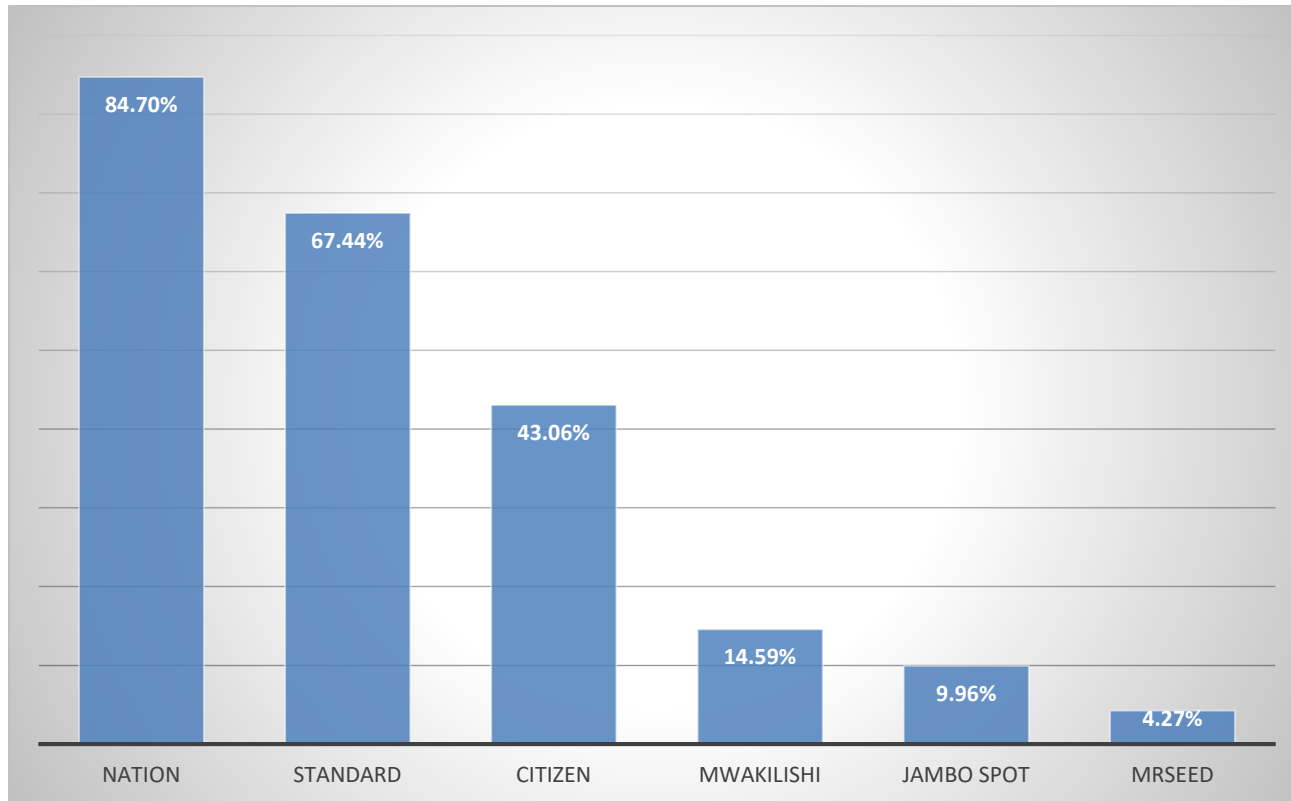
Level of interest in public affairs



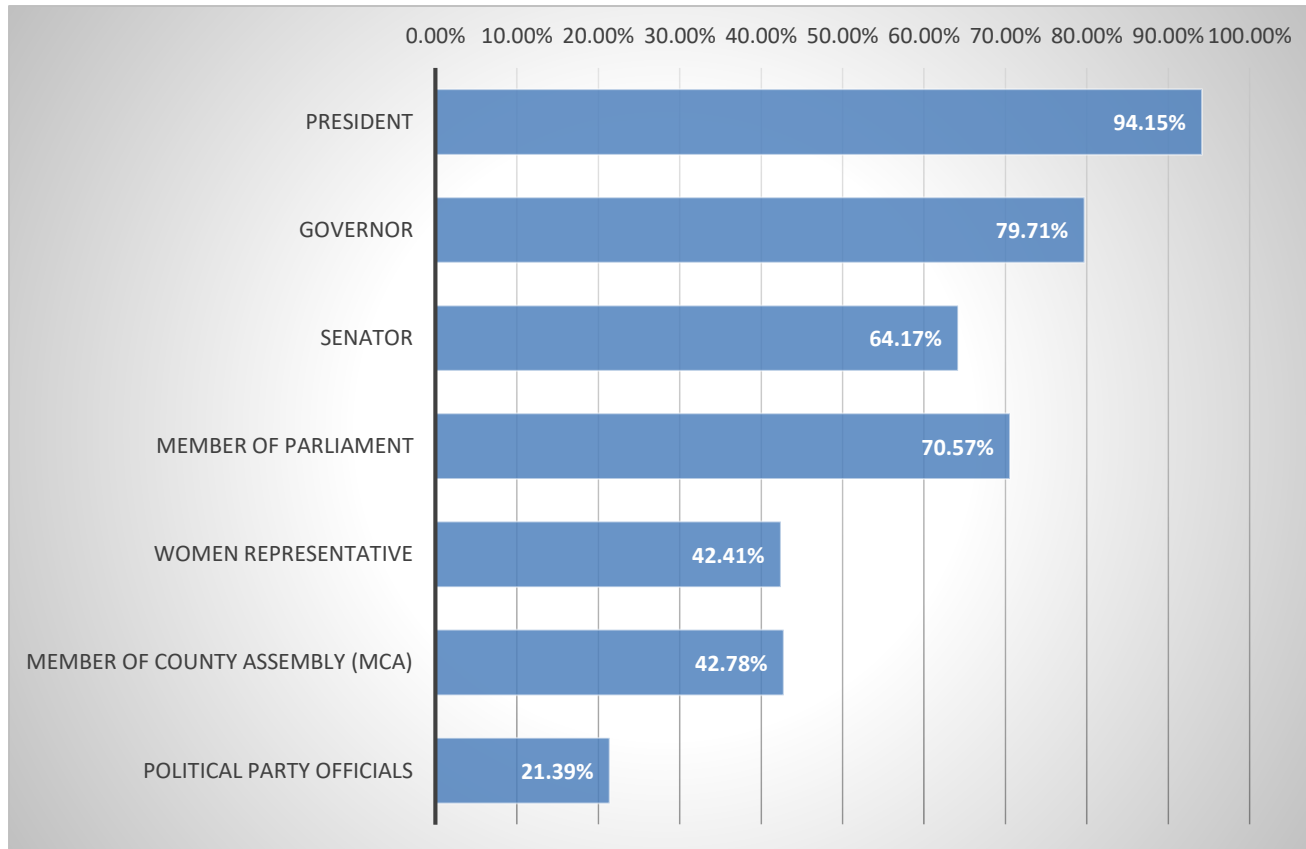
Most important source of news from Kenya



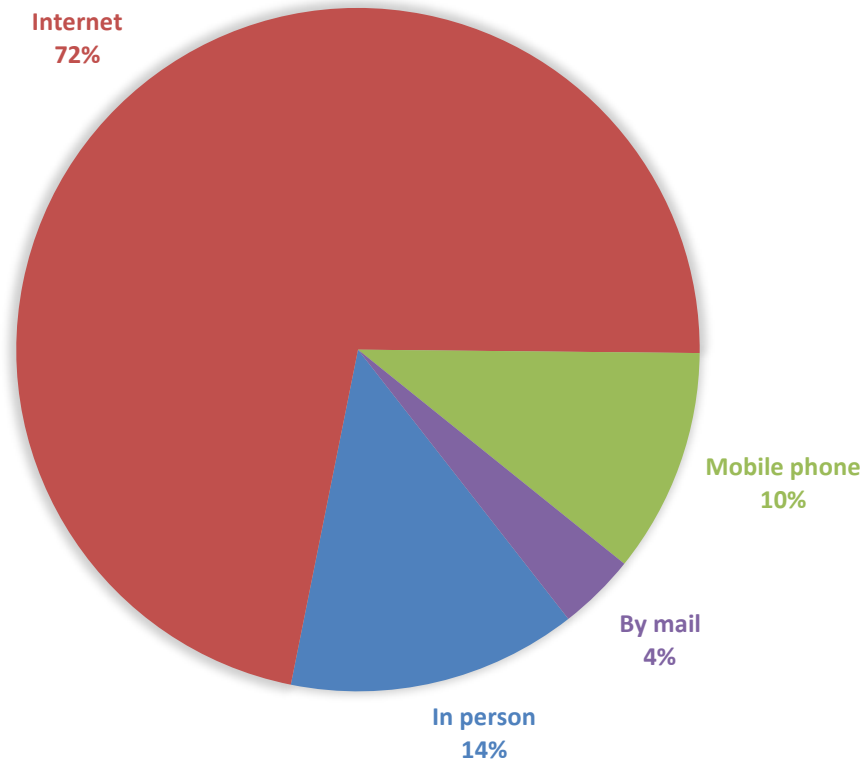
Which media source do you access most?



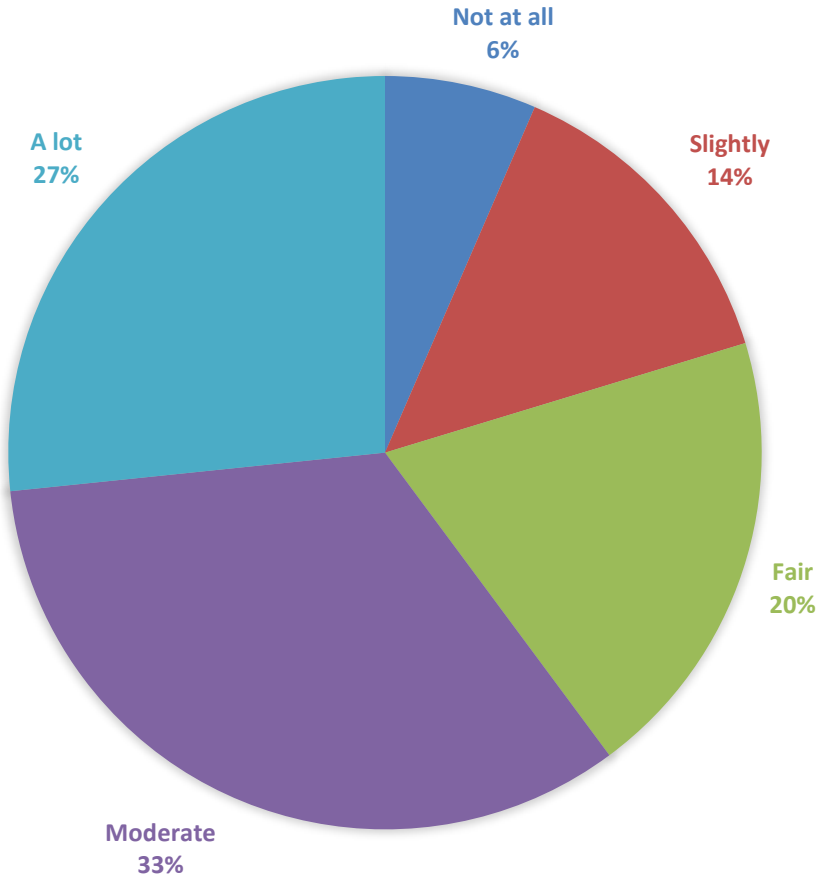
If you were able to vote, which position(s) would you want to vote for?



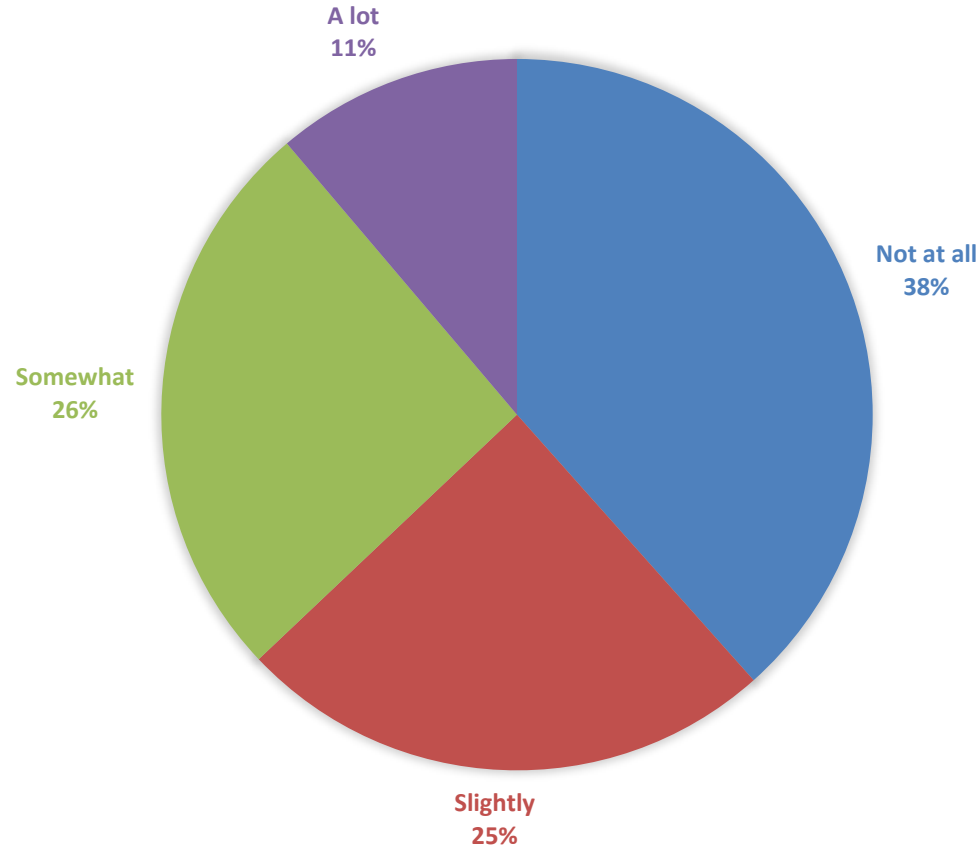
Preferred diaspora voting method
